

Baiting a minnow with the Spiral Eye™ side threading Bait needle



Pictured is a minnow being baited using a Spiral Eye™ bait needle with a #8 Treble hook attached to a 12" leader looped at the end

Insert the Spiral Eye bait needle into the bait at the vent and exit out of the mouth

Pull the leader loop through the bait
Carefully insert the shaft of the hook
into the vent.

>

Insert the needle through the bottom
jaw and come out of the left nostril



(note: nostril structure is tough and that is what keeps the bait from tearing apart while trolling.)

Tighten up the loop through the nostril

>

After the first nostril is sewed, repeat
the process on the second nostril.
With both nostrils sewn shut, tighten
the leader up to be just snug

The leader should come out of the
nostril and not the mouth,

>

The leader loop is then connected to
your line and you're ready to fish.
